

TERRA KIDSCAST

In this week's Kidscast, we heard about how God parted the Red Sea so His people could safely escape Pharaoh and his army. This craft is meant to help us remember that God always makes a way for His people. For this craft, you will need:

- ★ 1 piece of brown construction paper
- ★ 4 pieces of blue construction paper (in assorted shades of blue)
- ★ Scissors
- ★ Glue
- ★ Pencil
- ★ Second page of this PDF to help you as you make your craft.

1. First, draw a pathway on a dark blue piece of construction paper.
2. Next, cut along those lines, and glue the outer parts of the pathway on the brown piece of construction paper (see example on second page).
3. Now, take two pieces of dark blue construction paper, and fold each one "hot dog" style (long-ways). Glue half of each piece of folded construction paper to the back of the pathway we made in step 2.
4. Take a light blue piece of construction paper and draw 8 "waves." Cut those out, and glue 4 waves to each side of our folded papers we glued to the pathway from step 3.
5. Cut out 16 strips of light blue paper. These don't have to be even - mine were about 1 inch wide and 4 inches long. Only getting glue on one tip of each strip, glue 8 strips on the back of each folded dark blue piece of paper - so that most of the strip is visible.
6. Next, curl each strip down to make some sweet 3D waves.
7. Lastly, on the brown pathway, write "God always makes a way for His people! Exodus 13-14," so that you can remember this takeaway from our story.
