: Terra Nova Churches commit 10% of our giving towards the work of planting churches each year,

: To help minimize adminisitrative overhead, the Terra Family shares some operational & ministry related costs (such as insurance & professional fees). These expenses were higher in 2022 than expeceted due to insurance rate increases and a transition in our financial cards & systems. 2023 higher expenses include a website redesign project and a marriage retreat for all pastoral couples.

- : Giving was up modestly in 2022 and budgeted giving for 2023 aims for another year of modest growth.
- : Other Income is Benevolence giving & fees for Poiema Retreat and Elements programming. The related expenses are recorded in Community Outreach (benevolence) and Poiema & Elements expenses are in Discipleship. These expenses & related are not included in budget projections.
- : Facility Costs include \$34k of office renovation costs that will be funded by the use of savings reserves.

NOTES

: Church giving remained steady in 2022 with a slight increase in Church Planting Support. The 2023 budget includes an increase in church giving as we seek to rely less and less on outside support.

: Other Income includes facility rental fees, Executive Pastor Stipend & Network Imago Retreat Fees. The costs for the Imago retreat are not included in the budget and represent the higher Discipleship Expenses.

: Facility Costs are lower in 2022 from continuing COVID relief from our landlord. Rent expenses will increase in 2023 which is reflected in the 2023 budget.

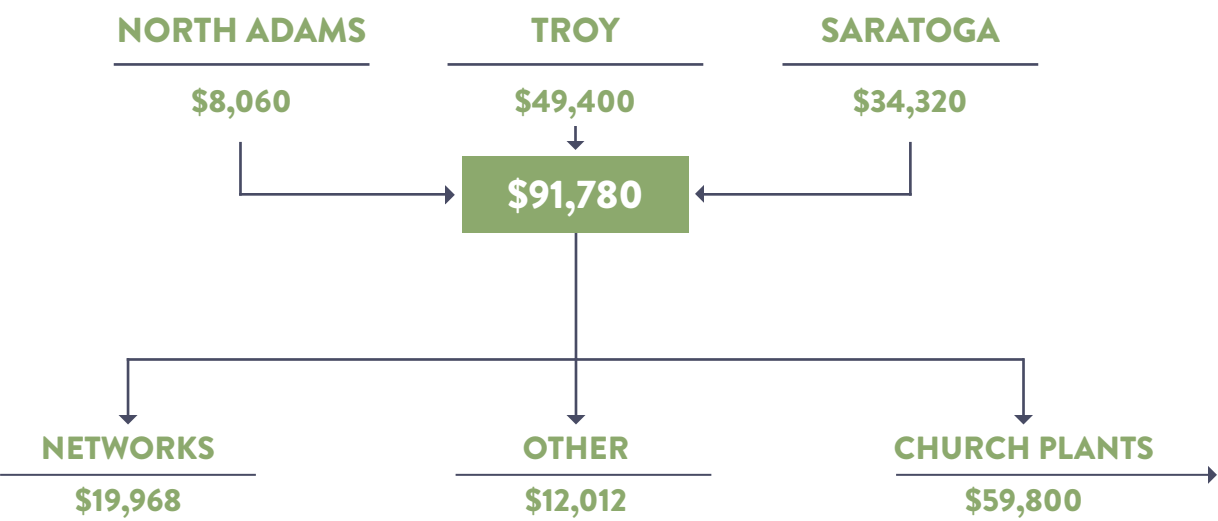

CHURCH PLANTING

Beyond our local communities, the Terra Family of churches work together to plant more churches so more people have the opportunity to pursue God, participate in the lives of other believers and have a church home. To do this, each Terra Nova Church commits to give 10% of its giving towards the work of church planting. In 2022, the Terra family invested \$80.9k in to church planting. In 2023, we are budgeting an investment of \$91.8k. The following lays out how we plan to make that investment in 2023.








We are proud partners with Acts 29 which plants churches worldwide and the Village Green Collective which focuses on church planting in New England.

This primarily includes funds for our Executive Pastor to coach, care for & connect with church planters and pastors.

In 2023 we will be supporting eight church plants!
